The COVID-19 pandemic brought about unprecedented challenges, profoundly impacting the socio-economic fabric of the nation. It led to a disruption of the public healthcare system, creating barriers to accessing even basic healthcare facilities, thereby affecting the poor and needy populations nationwide.

The 'Mass vaccination drive' implemented in Pune District was carried out to achieve herd immunity, reduce the spread of the virus, and mitigate the impact of the COVID-19 Pandemic. The drive was a critical and necessary response to the COVID-19 pandemic, addressing health, economic, and societal challenges. It represented a collective effort to protect lives, support recovery, and contribute to health security in Pune District. Relief support was provided in various ways, including supplying vaccines, providing ration kits, and extending medical equipment support to hospitals.



## 02 Key Activities

- Supporting the administrations in procurement of vaccines.
- 2,30,000 doses of vaccine administered at Kamalnayan Bajaj hospital, Aurangabad municipal corporation and District health hospital in the 1st lot of distribution.
- 2,30,000 doses of vaccine administered at PCMC and DHO Aurangabad in the 2nd lot.
- 2,47,000 doses of vaccine administered at PMC, PCMC and District hospital Aurangabad in the 3rd lot.

## 03 Key Impact

Hospitals, NGOs and Vaccination centres were able to make available all the required facilities for the drives.

The initiative supported the local administration when they were struggling to get supplies from government and significantly contributed during unprecedented Covid times. The model was applauded for its efficient planning and execution in timely delivery of vaccines to the needy.

The long-term health impact of the vaccination drive were improved population health, fewer long-term COVID-19 complications and a stronger healthcare infrastructure.
