Gokhale Bridge closed: Chaos, confusion on Day 1

THE FIRST day of closure of the Gokhale Bridge, which connects Andheri (east) and Andheri (west), on Monday led to heavy traffic snarls in the western suburbs with motorists complaining of inconvenience and traffic police having to increase manpower to deal with the chaotic situation.

Around 11 am, a heavy flow of traffic was seen on the Andheri subway and Amboli junction in the jurisdiction of D N Nagar traffic police division in Andheri (west). The south-bound stretch of S V Road saw heavy traffic in Andheri. Similar heavy traffic was seen in the evening peak hours from 4 pm to 9 pm, said police sources.

In a bid to create more space for the crawling traffic, the BMC removed over 100 hawkers on S V Road from morning till afternoon. In Santacruz division, Milan subway, and Thakare bridge saw heavy traffic. Captain Vinayak Gore flyover in Vile Parle, which connects east to west, as well as the Vile Parle junction from Andheri to Centaur Hotel on the western express highway, saw a heavy load of traffic.

'Alternate route inconvenient'

Though a signboard on the barricading of Gokhale Bridge suggests five alternate routes, citizens find the detour inconvenient. Rehan Sher Khan, a resident of Andheri (W), seemed confused about the

closure of the bridge. "I needed to go to the two-wheeler mechanic at the end of the bridge but now with the barricading it is a very long way around," said Rehan, who works in the Information Technology (IT) sector. He did not seem to know about the closure of the bridge until he came to the foot of the bridge.

Another resident of Andheri (W), Sandesh More, who works as a delivery executive for a tailor, said, "I take the rickshaw across the Gokhale Bridge while making my deliveries. Now, with the Vile Parle route congested, crossing the bridge on foot is the most convenient." Pedestrians have been taking the connector between east and west by foot. However, there seems to be no space for pedestrians to conveniently enter or exit the bridge.

Rickshaw driver Indrajit Yadav told The Indian Express that he has seen an increase in traffic all over Andheri. A resident of Andheri (E) himself, Yadav said, "My livelihood has taken a hit as a bulk of my passengers were between Andheri east and west. Now that the route is not being frequented, my earning has dropped." He said he will now be taking the Vile Parle bridge though he knows it would be overcrowded.

Like many others during the day, Sushil Singh also did not know of the bridge's closure until he came to its foot. Working as a delivery executive, Singh said, "The closure of the bridge is going to cause longer delays and detours which will only mean late deliveries." Travelling on his cycle, Singh was also unsure

which alternate path to take.

A traffic police officer near the Andheri railway station said on the condition of anonymity, "The alternate subways and bridges are narrow, causing the traffic to slow down."

Traffic police seek wardens

Several traffic police officials told The Indian Express that they doubled to tripled the number of policemen at the alternate routes to manage the heavy flow of traffic. A stop-gap arrangement has been made by shifting manpower internally. This has been provided to traffic divisions (Vakola, Santacruz, Oshiwara, D N Nagar, Goregaon, Jogeshwari) around the Gokhale bridge from other traffic divisions in central and eastern parts of Mumbai.

A traffic source said, "It is getting difficult to manage the traffic. The railways and the BMC need to speed up the work of Gokhale bridge and finish at least one side within two months. This will provide some relief."

Traffic police sources also added that they need more manpower from the Mumbai Police and have requested the BMC to provide them with 200 traffic wardens to help ease the traffic during peak hours.

Confirming the development of the request for traffic wardens, P Velrasu, additional municipal commissioner (Projects), BMC, said, "Yes. We usually provide these persons to divert and manage the traffic when additional manpower is needed."

'Expedite work': Citizens file online plea

MANY RESIDENTS have initiated an online petition, urging the railway and civic authorities to expedite the ongoing repair and reconstruction work along the Gopal Krishna Gokhale Bridge in Andheri and complete it at the earliest, after the bridge was shut down on Monday.

The traffic on the bridge is likely to start ahead of the 2023 monsoon. The Lohkhandwala Oshiwara Citizen's Association (LOCA) launched an online signature campaign on Sunday (November 6) evening and till Monday (November 7) afternoon, and nearly 1,798 residents from Andheri and Lohkhandwala have signed the petition for expediting the work.

Dhaval Shah, a petitioner and co-founder of LOCA, said that more than 8,000 people have viewed the petition and 612 people have shared it across various platforms in the past 24 hours.

"The primary objective of the petition

is to ensure that the authorities understand the importance of the project. Andheri is an education and commercial hub in the western suburbs, and there are dozens of schools and junior colleges, as well as industrial sectors. As the bridge has been shut, school buses will have to take a different route some two to five kilometres away. There is no nearby bridge that permits heavy vehicles... BMC needs to complete the bridge on war-footing so that vehicular movement could start there ahead of 2023 monsoon, otherwise commuting would be difficult as the suggested alternative routes like Andheri Subway and Milan Subway get severely waterlogged every monsoon," Shah said on Monday.

Another citizen's group from Andheri (East), meanwhile, has written to the Municipal Commissioner, urging him to propose the railway authorities to at least allow the south-bound railway footbridge at Andheri railway station accessible to school and college goers. Residents will not be allowed to use the railway footbridge without a valid ticket. "Also, the

request for the reconstruction of the Gokhale Bridge will be provided with a hefty bonus for the completion of the construction of the bridge within the next six months," said Nicholas Almeida, a member of Watchdog Foundation.

On November 1, the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) had written to the Mumbai traffic police, seeking suggestions on alternative routes owing to the closure of the bridge — a primary link that connects Andheri (East) and Andheri (West); following which the traffic department had suggested the Balasaheb Thackeray Flyover in Jogeshwari, Milan Subway in Santacruz, and Mrinaltai Gore Flyover as the possible alternatives. The routes — east-west connectors — will, however, cause commuters to travel an additional two to five kilometres daily.

The civic officials, meanwhile, have maintained that two lanes along the bridge be opened within the next six months to ensure smooth traffic.

18-yr-old who suffered burns on Diwali dies

AN 18-YEAR-OLD college student who had suffered 65 per cent burn injuries during Diwali celebrations on October 24, after her dupatta (stole) came in contact with an oil lamp and caught fire at her Khar residence, has succumbed to her injuries.

Khar police said Nidhi Makhwana died on November 5 due to infection and pneumonia. Around 8.30 pm on Diwali day, she was looking out of the window in the apartment gallery when her dupatta caught fire from an oil lamp. Her mother and uncle rushed her to the bathroom and doused the fire. But her injuries were of a serious nature because her stole was made of terycotton. She was rushed to a Bandra hospital before being shifted to Kasturba hospital. In her statement to the police, Makhwana said her dress accidentally caught fire. Hospital authorities told the police she suffered injuries to her legs and back. A case of accidental death has been registered by Khar police.

Shelar dares Aaditya to resign and contest bypolls

ON THE second day of its public rally 'Jagar Mumbaicha' (Awakening Mumbai), which was held at Gundavli in Andheri East on Monday evening, BJP Mumbai unit president Ashish Shelar attacked Shiv Sena leader Aaditya Thackeray and said he should resign from his World Assembly seat in South Mumbai, and show courage to face by-elections in Worli.

"Uddhav Thackeray said after the election results, that the torch was lit after Andheri East. Let them show the courage to face by-elections in Worli con-

stituency," Shelar said.

BJP kickstarted its month-long yatra named Jagar Mumbaicha on Sunday evening, with the first public rally in Bandra East, in the vicinity of the private residence of Shiv Sena (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray, named Matoshree, in Kalanagar in Bandra. The yatra is seen as a precursor to the BJP's full scale campaign for the upcoming BMC elections.

Shelar on Monday morning had taken to social media and said, "Mumbaikars' anger against Shiv Sena's Uddhav Balasaheb Thackeray has been exposed in the form of low voting percentage and NOTA. MVA was rejected by 70% of voters."

Yatra won't stop until Tricolour hoisted in Srinagar, says Rahul

RAHUL GANDHI'S much-touted 3,570-km 'Bharat Jodo Yatra' entered its Maharashtra leg on Monday with the Congress leader stating that no force could stop the yatra and that it will culminate only after the hoisting of the Tricolour in Srinagar.

Rahul made an entry into the state at Degloor in Nanded district at around 8 pm on Monday, where he was welcomed by the entire top brass of the state Congress. "We started from Kanyakumari with a Tricolour in our hand and nothing can stop this yatra until we hoist the flag in Srinagar," said Rahul, addressing the crowd gathered to welcome him in Maharashtra.

He was welcomed by the Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee (MPCC) near Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj statue in Kalamandir at Degloor before proceeding on a 'mashaal morcha' through the town.

Praising Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, Rahul said it was his good fortune that he was starting the Maharashtra leg of the yatra after taking blessings from the warrior king. "He

(Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj) is your history, he is an important symbol of Maharashtra," he said.

Rahul said he is walking to listen to people and to understand the problems faced by them. "We talk on unemployment, we talk on bad policies of the Narendra Modi government which have destroyed the economy of this country. We listen to you," he said. The yatra resumed after Rahul's speech with the participants carrying 'unity torches' and walking for over 9 km till Gurdwara Yaadgari Baba Zoravar Singh ji, Fateh Singh ji where Rahul offered Gurunank Gurupurab Ardas. November 8 is Guru Nanak Jayanti. The yatra halted for the night at Chidravar Mill in Degloor. Earlier, Telangana Congress chief Revanth Reddy handed over the Tricolour to Maharashtra party chief Nana Patole in a symbolic gesture announcing the beginning of the Maharashtra leg.

All senior Congress leaders from Maharashtra have landed in

Nanded to welcome the yatra. Subhash Wankhede, former Shiv Sena Lok Sabha MP and Uddhav Thackeray supporter, was present at the yatra to extend his greetings. Ally Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) on Monday said that party state president Jayant Patil, Baramati Lok Sabha MP Supriya Sule and MLA Jitendra Awhad will be walking with Rahul on November 10 and will also be attending the public rally along with him the same day. Shiv Sena is yet to confirm whether any member of the Thackeray family will attend the yatra.

The Maharashtra leg of the yatra is a 14-day event where Rahul will cover over 370 km starting from Degloor in Marathwada region to Jalgaon-Jamod in Buldhana district of Vidarbha.

In major reshuffle, 104 IPS officers get new postings in state

Mumbai: In one of the biggest and much-delayed transfers of Superintendent of Police-rank IPS officers in the state, 104 officers were transferred on Monday. Altogether, 14 officers have been posted to Mumbai which included DCP Akbar Pathan, who

had been named as an accused in an extortion case related to controversial IPS officer Param Bir Singh but was not charged before by the CID, which was then investigating the matter. Those posted to Mumbai include DCP Abhinav Deshmukh, former Raigad SP

Anil Paraskar, former Palghar SP Gaurav Singh, former Solapur SP Tejaswi Satpute and former Sindhudurg SP Dikshit Gedam among others.

This round of transfer follows the earlier transfer of 23 IPS officers in the state, and many of those were replaced in the earlier round of transfers. ENS

Cong slams Prakash Ambedkar over his tirade against Rahul

THE CONGRESS on Monday criticised Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi (VBA) leader Prakash Ambedkar after he questioned the need for Rahul Gandhi's Bharat Jodo Yatra whose Maharashtra leg began on Monday.

"Some leaders are making statements questioning the need of this yatra. They are saying that no harm has been done to India in the past eight years. It proves who wants to play spoilsport in the upcoming elections at the cost of Congress," state Congress president Nana Patole said. Ambedkar had questioned the need of the yatra saying nothing has been broken in the country. So the issue of binding India does not

arise. Patole wondered whether 'certain' leaders chose to purposely ignore news of lynchings, rising attacks on Dalits, lapses in national security, attacks on freedom of expression and finds no fault in it.

"We cannot help if someone purposely ignores India's problems and wants to pretend that everything is fine. We in Congress stand for unity and the yatra is for the same," said Patole. The Maharashtra Congress chief accepted that the yatra has filled the state Congress organisation with enthusiasm and each district unit is working tirelessly to make the yatra a success. "Electoral success is not the motive behind this yatra but we are sure that the manner in which the organisation in the state has swung into action, the electoral gains are sure to come."

18-year-old man arrested for 'sexually assaulting' minor he met online

Mumbai: The Mumbai Crime Branch on Monday arrested an 18-year-old man for allegedly sexually assaulting a minor in on Sunday. The two had allegedly befriended each other on Instagram.

The 14-year-old victim, a resident of the suburbs in the city, had left her home on Sunday evening and did not return till late night. When her family could not trace her, they filed a missing complaint at the local suburban police station. A team of officials from the police station and Crime Branch launched a probe.

Meanwhile, the accused dropped the victim near her house on a motorbike early Monday and escaped. On questioning, the minor told police that "they were Instagram friends". "The accused had convinced the victim to meet him near her house. They roamed around for some time, while the accused tried to maintain a physical relation with her," said an officer said. Based on the victim's statement, police added relevant sections of the IPC and POCSO Act, traced and arrested the 18-year-old. ENS

NCP leader forces cancellation of Marathi movie

NATIONALIST CONGRESS Party (NCP) leader and former Cabinet minister in the MVA government Jitendra Awhad on Monday forced the cancellation of the screening of Marathi movie 'Har Har Mahadev' that was being screened at a theatre in a Thane mall. There were complaints that some moviegoers were assaulted by the NCP workers as well.

Awhad, who led a number of NCP supporters inside the theatre, asked the patrons to leave, asserting that the movie allegedly "distorted the Marathi history and such movies would not be allowed to be released in the state". Police Deputy Commissioner of Police (Thane, Zone V) Vinay Kumar Rathod said they were in the process of registering an FIR for blocking the screening of the movie under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code. "We have increased security at the cinema hall, and an FIR is being registered. We will find out who was involved in the case," he said, adding that no complaints were filed.

The incident occurred hours after the NCP warned the film industry, asserting that "any distortion of history under the name of freedom of expression and cinematic liberty will not be tolerated, and such films will face opposition". The move came in support of Sambhaji Rajeev Chhatrapati from the Kolhapur royal family — a former Rajya Sabha member and descendant of Maratha warrior king Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj — who also warned that films distorting historical facts about Shivaji's life will be strongly opposed, with efforts being taken on preventing the release of such films.

This came in the wake of release of Marathi film 'Har Har Mahadev', and the announcement of upcoming film 'Vedat Marathe Veer Daudale Saat' during which state Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS) chief Raj Thackeray were present.

Sambhaji Rajeev on Sunday said, "A number of inaccuracies have been pointed out in the recently released movie, 'Har Har Mahadev'. We have also been hearing about fact distortion in 'Vedat Marathe Veer Daudale Saat'. We will stall the release of any other such film in the future."

After recently watching 'Har Har Mahadev', Maharashtra Cultural Affairs Minister Sudhir Mungantiwar also said that he will organise its show for the Cabinet. Maharashtra NCP President Jayant Patil, meanwhile, said that his party has always protected freedom of expression. "Producers, however, should not distort historical facts in films. They must show events as that happened. The NCP will not tolerate any fiddling of facts in the history of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj," according to Patil.

THE NATIONALIST Congress Party (NCP) on Monday held a protest outside Maharashtra Agriculture Minister Abdul Sattar's official residence here for allegedly using objectionable words against their leader and Baramati MP Supriya Sule in Sillod in Aurangabad district. The minister was also escorted from across the state. The minister insisted that while he hadn't made a remark against Sule, he was ready to apologise.

Sattar had allegedly used a derogatory term while referring to Sule in response to the "50 khokha" jibe that the rebel Shiv Sena MLAs who parted ways

Uddhav Thackeray have been facing since they broke away, leading to the collapse of the Maha Vikas Aghadi government.

"An extremely crass and shameful statement on Mrs Supriya Sule by Maharashtra minister Abdul Sattar. This is an insult to all women and shows his cheap mindset. Abdul Sattar and his likes should stop testing our patience because we know how to protect the dignity of our women," NCP spokesperson Clyde Crasto said.

The party demanded that CM Eknath Shinde sack Sattar from his Cabinet within 24 hours or face a statewide agitation. It also wrote to the local police, demanding an FIR against Sattar. NCP state president and former

water resources minister Jayant Patil also tweeted, addressing CM Shinde to sack Sattar. "Sattar has made many controversial statements in the past. Chief Minister Eknathrao Shinde should immediately take the resignation from Abdul Sattar (sic)," he tweeted.

While Sattar said he was ready to apologise, he added that he did not say anything objectionable. "I respect women. I have not said a single word about women. If my words have hurt the hearts of sisters, I am willing to apologise. However, I have not said anything like that," he said.

Shiv Sena (BBS) spokesperson and minister Deepak Kesarkar expressed regret on behalf of their party. "We all respect Sharad Pawar saheb and Supriya Sule ji

and we keep saying that no one should use any wrong or insulting words against them. I wish to clarify that no one should make any personal remarks against them. I am expressing regret to Sule ji on behalf of our party and hoping that the issue will be resolved now. Also, only CM Shinde will give whatever instructions Sattar ji has to be given," he said.

Sources said CM Shinde is also upset with Sattar and has instructed him to extend an apology to Sule.

Meanwhile, state women's commission chairperson Rupali Chakankar has issued a notice to state Director General of Police Rajnish Seth, instructing him to initiate action against Sattar, and submit his report to them.

Fulfilled promises to a certain extent: CJJ in farewell meet

CHIEF JUSTICE of India U U Lalit Monday recalled the promises he made while taking over in August this year and said he has fulfilled them "to a certain extent." "As I stand before you I remember certain promises which I made when I took over as Chief Justice of India. And I said that I will try to streamline the listing patterns, I will see that there is at least one constitution bench functioning all through, I will see that regular matters are listed at an expedited date and ease the mentioning part", CJJ Lalit, who is set to retire Tuesday, said while addressing a farewell event organised by the Supreme Court Bar Association.

"I must say to a certain extent I have been able to fulfil those promises," he said adding that "from the first day I took over till today, we have been able to dispose of more than 10,000 matters. In addition we have also disposed of 13,000 matters which were lying in defect for several years, but

they were simply being maintained on the file". The disposal figure was thus 1,300 more than the filing, he said adding "which means to a certain extent we have been able to take a slice out of the mounting arrears".

The CJJ said he had come first to the SC to mention a matter before the then CJJI V Chandrachud, "That was my first day. Now I am passing on the baton to the son of that illustrious Chief Justice, Justice D Y Chandrachud," he added.

Speaking on the occasion, CJJ-designate Justice Chandrachud lauded CJJ for "showing remarkable leadership" and said "during my tenure, I hope to provide continuity to all the good work that Chief Justice Lalit has begun".

Govt rejects inquiry report on Deven Bharti filed by former DGP

THE MAHARASHTRA government has rejected an inquiry report filed by former DGP Sanjay Pandey against IJS officer Deven Bharti in connection with allegations made by convicted criminal Vijay Palande against Bharti. Sanjay Pandey had been asked to conduct an inquiry by the Maha Vikas Aghadi government following which he had submitted two reports. An official from the home department said the closure report says there was no merit found in the allegations made by Palande and that the process of law had not been followed in ordering the inquiry. Hence, the reports by Pandey were rejected. The submission by Bharti denying the allegations against him was accepted by the department. Bharti is a 1994 batch IPS offi-

cer and is posted as the additional director general of the Maharashtra State Security Corporation. Recently, Bharti's name was also dropped as an accused in a case where forged documents were allegedly procured by Reshma Khan, wife of BJP leader Hyder Azam, to procure a passport. Palande is serving life sentence in Talaja jail in Navi Mumbai after being convicted in several cases, including murder. Palande was convicted for a double murder in 2002, jumped parole, allegedly changed his locks and killed two other men 10 years later in 2012.

BMC to empanel agencies to hold online exams for vacant posts

FOR EASE and transparency during hiring to fill vacancies, the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) will empanel agencies for conducting various competitive online examinations. Recently it floated tenders to invite these agencies with their proposals.

Milind Sawant, joint municipal commissioner incharge of the General Administration Department in BMC said, "The tender is for empanelling the agencies. Once such empanelment happens, every department can take agencies from this set and give work orders." BMC's move follows a government resolution of May 2022 describing the criteria based on which such recruitment agencies can be appointed. The agencies will be responsible for end-to-end organisation of these online examinations such as collection of applications and examination fees. They will also be the ones issuing admit cards, preparation of the question bank software for reshuffling, making question sets and conducting online computer-based examinations. In the general administration department alone, 1,800 positions of clerks are vacant, according to Sawant. As per Sainath Rajadyaksha, who heads the BMC engineers' workers union, 35 per cent posts are vacant at the engineers' levels.
